As you prepare for the transition into high school, it is very important that you understand the course selection process, the graduation requirements and the University of California and California State University system eligibility requirements known as A-G (see table below). Understanding this information will help you and your student make the right choices when picking your classes.

Selecting Your 9th Grader's Schedule:

All 9th grade students will take 6 classes. Five of those classes are requirements plus one elective. See listing below. Your student will be asked to rank order 8 elective choices. Your student should make their choices based on interest taking into consideration high school graduation and college admissions requirements. See boxes below. Please note that your student may be placed in an unselected support class if your student has an IEP or is part of the ELD program. 
