Entering 10th Grade Students New to AUSD—2023-2024 School Year

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Please read these guidelines completely as they contain important information about your student's high school course selection. It is important that you understand the course selection process, AP/Honors policy (available on the website) graduation requirements (reviewed below), and the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) eligibility requirements (reviewed below) referred to as A-G subjects. Knowing this information will help you and your student make the right choices when picking their classes.

Important Information to Consider:

- All sophomores must be enrolled in six (6) classes
- Students should consult the Course Catalog (available on the website) to view course information and required prerequisites to make informed decisions about class choices.
- Students are not allowed to skip prerequisite levels especially in math.
- Students should consider their class options carefully taking into consideration not only the rigor of individual classes but the overall rigor of their complete schedule. Additionally, there is no guarantee that students will be able to make class changes in the future.
- All course selection forms must be signed by a parent / guardian. Students will not be placed in AP / Honors courses without a parent/guardian signature.
- Students earn graduation credits by earning grades of "D" or higher in their classes. For each class passed, five (5) credits will be issued per semester for a total of ten (10) credits per class per year.
- "D" grades do not meet the A-G subject requirements for UC / CSU admissions.
- Courses cannot be repeated for credit unless otherwise noted in the course catalog and on the reverse. A student can only
 earn a maximum of ten (10) credits per course. If a student chooses to repeat a class for which they have already earned a
 passing grade and credits, the previously earned credits will be removed from the student's credit total and potentially
 create credit deficiencies toward graduation. Students should consult with their counselor prior to repeating a course.
- Students should be mindful of the AP/Honors Policy listed on the website (Students- Course Catalog & Selection).
- Two Years of PE is required for Graduation. Students are encouraged to complete this requirement as sophomores. Students may qualify for a PE Exemption for the second year of PE based on successful participation on school sports teams. To qualify for a PE Exemption, a student must pass one year of a PE class and successfully complete two seasons of a school sport. The paperwork is available on the school website (Students- Athletics).
